PUBLIC REALM WORKS

NOTICE OF PENDING START

THIS IS TO LET YOU KNOW THAT WE HAVE APPPOINTED SEYMOUR CIVIL ENGINEERING CONTRACTORS LIMITED TO CARRY OUT THE PUBLIC REALM WORKS FOR THE PROJECT.

THESE WORKS HAVE BEEN ON DISPLAY IN THE PROJECT OFFICE, 97 HIGH STREET FOR THE LAST FEW MONTHS.

THE WORKS WILL ENTAIL:

1. **Re-paving both sides of the High Street.**
2. **Providing tree planting on both sides of the High Street, level with the Co-op Food Store.**
3. **New street furniture – bins, bollards, benches and cycle racks.**
4. **Two new landscaping schemes:**
 - a. **at the corner of the Hills and the High Street, consisting of new paving, planting and seating.**
 - b. **in front of the land next to the Co-op Food Store, consisting of a walled and railed planting bed with space to mount a new mosaic depicting Skelton's history.**

SEYMOUR'S WILL BE SETTING UP THEIR SITE COMPOUND, WHICH WILL BE SITUATED ON THE OLD HOME FARM SITE BEHIND THE CHURCH, **STARTING ON MONDAY MAY 22ND.**

THE WORKS IN THE HIGH STREET WILL **COMMENCE ON TUESDAY 30TH MAY** AND WILL LAST FOR NINE WEEKS.

THE CONTRACTORS WILL BE ENSURING ACCESS IS MAINTAINED TO PREMISES DURING THE WORKS. THERE WILL BE DISRUPTION BUT IT WILL BE MINIMISED. PERSONS WHO PARK THEIR VEHICLES ON LAND NEXT TO THE CO-OP FOOD STORE SHOULD NOTE THAT THE AREA OCCUPIED BY THE FRONT ROW OF VEHICLES WILL BE FENCED OFF FOR PART OF THE CONTRACT TO ALLOW CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW PLANTING BED, WALL AND RAILINGS.

The contractors will be keeping people informed of their work by letter and by attendance at the Skelton Villages Civic Pride Coffee mornings held in the Skelton Civic Hall at 10.00 Mondays (statutory holidays excluded).
