Dear Resident/Business,

Skelton Car Park Site Redevelopment – High Street Traffic Regulation Order/Road Closure, 68 High Street, Skelton

With reference to above matter, please note that a temporary traffic regulation order/road closure will need to be put into force from 16 August 2021 until 22 August 2021 inclusive, with this road closure being in place for 24 hours throughout each day for the duration of the stated period.

As part of the planned civils work to be undertaken to create a new formal car park, there is a need to make a new drainage connection as part of the wider car park redevelopment proposals. This requires a saddle connection be made to the existing manhole within the existing carriageway (Coniston Rd). Therefore, to allow this work to happen, this section of public highway (as identified in the accompanying map/plan), is required to be closed off to vehicular traffic.

I appreciate that this road closure will cause some degree of inconvenience, but this work is necessary to allow the council's proposals to undertake the detailed civils work to be successfully achieved.

For the duration of the works to create a new formal council car park on this 68 High Street site, there will be the need to utilise all existing car parking provision in and around the Skelton High Street.
